MONDAY 12 SEPTEMBER: ROME, PAPAL AUDIENCE

*The Organizing Committee would like to give the possibility to all team members to take part in a Papal Audience, where they will have the chance to meet the Holy Father Pope Francis. Consider that at the time when this invitation is sent, the audience is not yet confirmed, as the procedures in order to get it are quite long. If confirmed, the audience will take place in Rome on **Monday, September 12th** in the morning. If*

interested, teams have to communicate the number of people that would like to participate, sending an e-mail to segreteria@skirollrieti.com within July 29th. After this date, the Organizing Committee will communicate very soon to all the interested teams if the audience is confirmed and, if so, you will obviously get any useful further information.

4.1 ROLLER SKI EQUIPMENT

For the Interval Start competition in Amatrice, LOC will provide free technique roller skis, with the following technical specifics:

- wheels material: rubber
- frame material: aluminum
- length: 600 mm
- weight: 1300 grams per pair

Here some pictures of the provided model. Please consider that the roller ski that you will have for the race, differently from the pictures, won't have any mounted mudguards.



Information regarding ski bindings (SNS Pilot or NNN) for the interval start competition (skating roller ski) must be indicated for each athlete in the preliminary entry.

Official provider: L'ESS Snc di Munari Paolo & C. (info@lessskiroll.it) - Please refer to the company for any further information regarding the provided roller ski.

All roller skis will be marked. Athletes or teams are not allowed to make any adjustments to roller skis or wheels including lubrication. Distribution of skating roller skis will be done before the start of the official training on September 9th, then all athletes will have to return them, and on the following day, roller ski will be again distributed before the start of the race. At the end of the competition, roller skis must be obviously returned again.

For the mass start race in classic technique Rieti - Terminillo and for the sprint competition in free technique in Rieti, teams have to use their own roller skis, that must be in compliance with FIS rules.

FIS ICR 396.2.6: Cross-Country ski poles must be used with Cross-Country skiing tips. Alternatively, poles tips must have safety rigid plastic protections with diameter ≥ 30 mm. These protections must be placed maximum 45 mm above the metallic tips.



According to ICR 343.5: Competitors must wear/use all the means of identification (bibs, leg bibs, transponders, GPS...) provided by the organizer. Transponders must be returned to the Race Office after the finish of each race. In case of losing bib or transponder, the competitor must pay a fee to the OC (20 € for a bib, 70 € for a transponder).

5. RULES & INFO

5.1 ENTRIES

The entries must be sent via **FIS online system**. Pre-entries and entries are copy-pasted from the Senior event (ROL WSC) to the Junior event (ROL JWSC) and vice versa. Therefore, please check carefully that you enter your athletes for the correct races, meaning junior athletes only for junior races and seniors respectively only for senior races:

- *42 days before the first competition (29th July 2022):* deadline for sending preliminary entries and accommodation requests
- *8 days before the first competition (1st September 2022):* deadline for sending final entries

Only competitors with an **active FIS Code** and entered by the NSA are allowed to participate in FIS Roller Ski World Cup.

5.2 ACCOMMODATION

Teams/athletes will be accommodated in hotels of a good standard in Amatrice and/or Rieti (headquarter of the Roller Ski World Cup events).

The hotels are appropriate to the needs of the athletes, with particular attention given to the selection of food and to mealtimes. Three meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) per day will be served at the hotel, included one soft drink per meal.

Single room/double room single use: reservation of single rooms will be permitted only if accommodation in double rooms is numerically impossible.

Deadline for bookings

Within 29th July 2022 (same deadline also for sending preliminary entries) the quantity of double and single rooms requested, as well as arrival/departure days, must be communicated. Please note that after this date the LOC won't be able to guarantee the availability of the rooms and agreed prices.

As soon as the Official Incoming Agency receives the requests, a detailed offer will be sent to the NSA.

Payment

Teams will pay directly in their hotels.

Cancellation Fee

Until 13 days before the first competition, teams can change (cancel) their bookings by adapting the preliminary entry.

Cancellation (entire team or only some rooms) after 12 days before the first competition leads to full payment for the accommodation.

5.4 TRANSPORT

Teams travelling by plane have the possibility to get free transportation from/to the competition venue, according to the following conditions:

- the LOC can offer only one free of charge transfer per team from the official airport to the venue and one from the venue to the airport
- the departure and arrival times must be communicated to the organiser latest 10 days before the first competition via FIS entry system

The official airports are ROMA FIUMICINO and ROMA CIAMPINO. Travel time from both airports to Rieti is about 1 hour and 30 minutes.

5.5 INSURANCE

All participants must have an insurance coverage, according to article 212.3 of the current ICR. The LOC is not liable for any kind of accident, injury, damage or lost property.

5.6 COVID-19 PROTOCOL & FIS PASSPORT

According to official communication from FIS office on 23 May 2022, for summer events 2022 **National LOC prevention program will prevail**. FIS continues to recommend basic hygiene and masks use, but **FIS Passport will not be used during summer 2022**.

At the date of 19th July 2022, in Italy there is the requirement to use FFP2 masks on:

- trains used in Interregional, Intercity, Intercity Night and High Speed passenger rail transport services
- buses used for passenger transport services, with undifferentiated offer, carried out on the road in a continuous or periodic manner on a route connecting more than two regions and having routes, schedules, frequencies and prices predetermined
- buses used for rental services with driver
- vehicles used in local or regional public transport services

Please note that due to Covid-19 restrictions and regulations, the current situation can change very quickly and therefore the LOC could be obliged to do some necessary adjustments or changes. Please consider also that the national prevention protocol in Italy could change by the time of the competition dates.

5.7 ACCREDITATION

It won't be necessary to make any specific accreditation request, as the data for the accreditation of teams will be imported automatically through the entries sent online by each NSA.

The accreditations for all team members will be delivered after the teams presentation in Amatrice on Thursday 8th September.
